GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION FRIDAY, MARCH 29

Christians around the world are united in a special way during Lent, Holy Week, and Easter.

Once a year, on **Good Friday**, parishes everywhere are called to support Christians living in the Holy Land. As a *Pontifical Collection requested by POPE FRANCIS*, this Collection offers an opportunity to be witnesses of peace and help protect the holy sites while helping others house and feed the poor, provide religious formation and education, maintaining shrines, and conducting pastoral ministry.



GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Abstinence is a penitential practice which consists of refraining from the consump-

tion of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older.

Good Friday is also a Day of Fasting. Fasting means that one full meal is allowed; and two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Fasting also means that eating between meals is not permitted, although drinking of liquids is allowed. Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive), and should continue onto Holy Saturday.
