**GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF  
FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

**Abstinence** is a penitential practice which consists of **refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older.**

**Good Friday** is also a **Day of Fasting**. **Fasting** means that **one full meal** is allowed; and **two smaller meals**, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. **Fasting** also means that **eating between meals is not permitted**, although drinking of liquids is allowed. **Fasting** is to be observed by **all Catholics** between the **ages of 18-59 years** (inclusive), and should continue onto Holy Saturday.
