Out of reverence for the *exposed* Blessed Sacrament, it is important that someone be present in the chapel at all times of exposition.

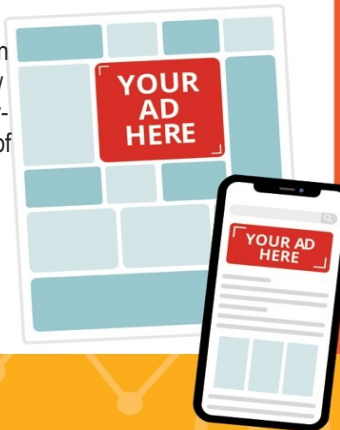

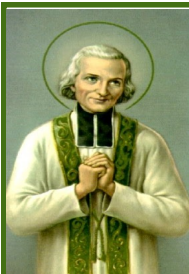

## St. John Marie Vianney Feast day August 4

**Saint John Vianney**, universally known as the "**Cure of Ars**," and internationally known for his priestly and pastoral work in his parish in **Ars, France**, because of the radical spiritual transformation of the community and its surroundings, attributed to his saintly life, mortification, his persevering ministry in the sacrament of confession, and his ardent devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

**St. John-Baptiste Marie Vianney** was ordained a priest in 1815. Three years later he was named parish priest of Ars, a remote French hamlet, where his reputation as a confessor and director of souls made him known throughout the Christian world.

Accustomed to the most severe austerities, beleaguered by swarms of penitents, and besieged mentally, spiritually and physically **by the devil**, this great mystic manifested an imperturbable patience.

He was a wonderworker loved by the crowds, but he retained a childlike simplicity, and he remains to this day the living image of the priest after the heart of Jesus.

He heard confessions of people from all over the world. During the last ten years of his life, **he spent sixteen to eighteen hours a day in the confessional**. His life was filled with works of charity and love.

He died August 4, 1859, and was canonized May 31, 1925. In 1929 he was made **patron saint of parish priests**. In 2009, **Pope Benedict XVI** named John Vianney **patron saint of all priests worldwide**.

**\*\*This year's feast day observance is superseded by the August 4th Sunday celebration.**
