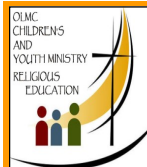

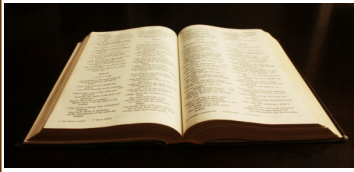

With the help of friends, and benefactors, the foundation currently owns and operates a Catholic kindergarten and primary school while also supporting an orphanage.

They provide water filters to the people of Marbial so they have safe water to drink, cook, and bathe. The foundation built a medical center which was dedicated on June 15, 2022 and also operates a dialysis center in Port-au-Prince.

All funds collected go directly to the foundation and they feel truly blessed to provide resources to the community despite the unrest that is happening in the country of Haiti.
