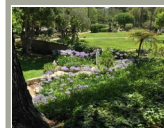

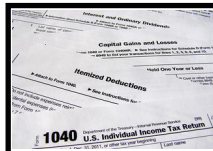
RETREAT WITH IMMACULÉE ILIBAGIZA JANUARY 24-25, 2025 AT OLMC

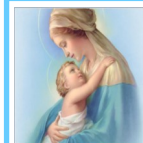
