Mass will be celebrated at 7:45am at the Chapel and 8:00am, 5:30pm and 7:00pm at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.

GUIDELINES REGARDING FASTING & ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays during Lent are Days of Absti-Abstinence nence. Additionally, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are Days of Fast.

What does this mean to you?

 Abstinence is a penitential practice to be observed on Ash Wednesday and All Fridays during Lent. It means refraining from the consumption of meat and meat by-products and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older (and unlike *fasting*, there is **no ending upper age limit**.)

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are also days of Fasting: Fasting means that one full meal; and two smaller meals may be taken, sufficient to maintain strength according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Fasting also means that eating or snacking between meals is not permitted, although drinking of liquids is allowed.

The Penance of Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive).
